

# Fairburn Park & Ride Fact Sheet

## Overview

The City of Fairburn in partnership with the South Fulton Community Improvement District (CID) have created a 200-space park and ride lot for carpool, vanpool, and MARTA bus commuters.



## Location

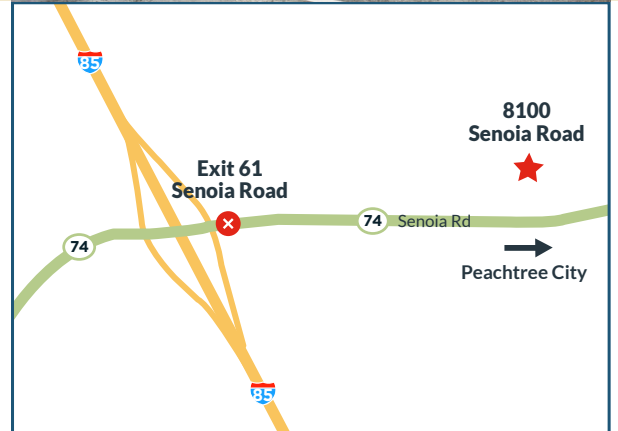

## Amenities

- Electric vehicle charging stations
- Reserved handicap parking spaces
- Convenient location to SR 74/I-85 interchange
- Pick-up and drop-off for MARTA Route 188: Oakley Industrial, with direct access to College Park Station

## Project Details

The park and ride was led by the City of Fairburn in partnership with the South Fulton CID. The project activated local jurisdictions, businesses, and the South Fulton CID to develop the park and ride in advance of the I-85 and SR 74 interchange reconstruction scheduled to begin in 2022. The park and ride is designed to relieve an uptick in congestion anticipated to occur while the reconstruction of the interchange takes place.



## QUICK STATS

- The City of Fairburn and the South Fulton CID made a **\$1.47 million investment** in the park and ride
- It can service up to **200 carpools and vanpools** a day
- Located **less than a mile** from the busy SR 74/I-85 interchange
