

ADVANCING INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS THAT KEEP THINGS MOVING IN SOUTH FULTON.

The South Fulton CID is a self-taxing group of property owners working together to facilitate business and community development through transportation improvements in partnership with government officials, business professionals and members of the surrounding community. It has two clear objectives:



Enhance mobility and safety through the improvement of existing transportation infrastructure for those who work, reside, shop and commute in and to the South Fulton CID area.



Enhance economic vitality and promote orderly growth in South Fulton.



INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS KEEP SOUTH FULTON MOVING

Each year the South Fulton CID directly invests in infrastructure and economic development to improve accessibility for commuters, customers, and suppliers. The following projects are currently underway or planned:

2023	Upgraded intersection ramps on US 29 at SR 74 and at McLarin Road
2023	Adding left turn lane from Oakely Industrial Boulevard into SC Johnson
2023	Annual Small Grants fund
2023	SR 74 Park and Ride promotion
2023-2024	Engage in US 29 Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) concepts
2023-2024	Actively participate in SR 74 at I-85 interchange engineering, reconstruction and landscaping/multi-use trail
2023-2024	Gullatt Road reclamation (includes paving Cleckler Road)
2023-2024	Improve and extend Oakley Industrial Boulevard from Creekwood to Gullatt Road
2023-2024	Design and seek grants for a Pedestrian Bridge across CSX Railroad Tracks from US 29 to McLarin
2024	CSX train alerts on SR 74
2024	Extend MARTA Route 181 along SR 74
2024-2025	Conduct Gullatt Road Interchange Justification Report (IJR)
2024-2025	Fill in sidewalk gaps along Oakley Industrial Boulevard from Bohannon Road to SR 74
2025	Oakley Industrial Boulevard at SR 74 intersection improvements
2025	Oakley Industrial Boulevard at SR 92 intersection improvements
Beyond 2025	Multi-use Trail extension along SR 74 North of I-85 Interchange to US 29
Beyond 2025	Expand SR 74 Park and Ride Lot
