

SR 74 at I-85 Interchange Reconstruction

Anticipated Completion

Fall 2027

Project Background

The I-85 South interchange is a gateway to one of the largest southeastern logistics corridors, and SR 74 is a significant commuting corridor for Fayette County. Currently, freight and commuter traffic is slowed down considerably when merging onto I-85 from the South Fulton CID area.

Project Description

The South Fulton CID designed a new partial cloverleaf interchange to help traffic get onto the interstate more efficiently. The planned 0.4 miles of improvements will also include **new or wider on- and off-ramps, wider bridges over I-85, and new traffic signals**. See the project plan below for greater detail.
